ED Report

A member raised concern on 1/21/25 regarding non-profit status because of tax filing issue. ED said that the issue has been resolved.

ED said that the purpose of these sessions is to take the actuals from first half of the year to project for the full year.

These will help us in drawing up the 2025-2026 budget in August-September.

Pacifica currently has 1 full-time and 2 part-time bookkeepers.

People flagging individual items helps.

R. Paul Martin and Fred Dodsworth both asked that station management participate in these sessions.

There was extensive discussion on various line items on the WBAI budget. One item of note was the high utility bills at WBAI.

James Sagurton explained the peculiar way in which utilities are billed in New York.

We are not happy with the current accounting system and are trying to bring uniformity. ED asked the audit firm for suggestions on accounting software

Myla Reson raised the issue of the need to have accurate accounting of volunteer labor. ED acknowledged that this was important not only for elections but to show the donors the value of volunteer labor.

ED also noted the need for a volunteer coordinator. Pacifica has 980 volunteers.

R. Paul Martin and Myla Reson emphasized the importance of union donations being reflected in the budget.

James Sagurton raised the importance of itemizing listener support instead of lumping them together, so we can keep track of what works and what does not work
